ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Chief Judge of the Twenty-Sixth Judicial District consisting of Stanton, Grant, Haskell, Morton, Stevens, and Seward County District Courts, hereby enters this Administrative Order addressing the division of the Court Trustee fee for the Twenty-Sixth Judicial District, as assessed pursuant to Local Rule 128, entered November 1, 2017.

WHEREUPON, the Court finds that an administrative order is needed to address how the 5% fee is assessed on all cases that are enforced by the District Court Trustees. Orders entered prior to January 1, 2018, do not have the fee assessed, and accordingly without action, the fee would come out of the obligees funds, which the court finds not in the best interest of the children of the 26th Judicial District. The Judges of the District Court have decided that the fee shall be split equally between the parties for all cases enforced by the District Court Trustees in Stanton, Grant, Haskell, Morton, Stevens, and Seward Counties of Kansas.

THEREFORE, THE COURT ENTERS THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1. Child support cases that are enforced by the District Court Trustee shall have a fee of 5.0% as set by Rule 128. The fee shall be shared equally by both parties, obligor and obligee. The amount shown on line F.3. of the Child Support Worksheet should be multiplied by 2.5%. This fee will be added on line F.4. to the total monthly support obligation. This shall be completed on all child support worksheets entered on and after January 1, 2018.

2. Maintenance cases that are enforced by the District Court Trustee shall have a fee of 5.0% as set by Rule 128. The fee shall be shared equally by both parties, obligor and obligee. The total amount of maintenance ordered should be multiplied by 2.5%. This fee will be added to all maintenance orders entered on and after January 1, 2018.

3. Any orders of support that were entered prior to January 1, 2018, that are or become enforced by the District Court Trustees, shall automatically have the fee set forth in paragraph 1 and 2 above at the time they are assigned to the District Court Trustee pursuant to Rule 128. The District Court Trustees shall file any income withholding orders necessary to reflect the same.

4. This order is effective January 1, 2018.
