## First case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) identified in Stevens County

**Hugoton** – Stevens County Health Department is announcing the first case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in Stevens County.

The case involves a male who traveled to an area outside of Stevens County with a high incidence of COVID-19 transmission. The Stevens County Health Department is working to identify all close contacts of this individual and those who were exposed are being contacted. We have provided instruction to these case contacts to monitor for symptoms of COVID-19, to include fever and respiratory symptoms. No further information about the patient will be released.

Please adhere to the following recommendations:

- Avoid non-essential trips and stay home to the extent you can.
- Follow all recommendations regarding self-quarantine
- Avoid large gatherings (groups of more than 10)
- If you do need to go out in public, ensure you maintain six feet distance from other people.

The Stevens County Health Department has worked closely on these decisions with numerous community partners, including Stevens County Government, The City of Hugoton, Stevens County Emergency Management, Stevens County Hospital, and leadership of our local public-school districts.
