

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
ELECTION CANVASS
August 11, 2026

8:30 AM – Election Canvass

The Board of Stevens County Commissioners met as the board of county canvassers to canvass the primary election which was held on August 4, 2026, with all members present. County Clerk Amy Jo Tharp was also present.

Tron opened the election canvass session.

Election night totals, mail totals, and early in person totals were reviewed and approved. Two (2) ballots were full hand count from the election which were not provisional.

Amy presented the commissioners with 12 provisional ballots, the commissioners reviewed the provisional votes and decided based on the Kansas statutes which ballots should be accepted and rejected.

Two ballots were rejected, one (1) due to voter not in the pollbook for Stevens County, one (1) voter did not present valid ID before canvass. Two mail ballots were rejected, one (1) due to missing signature of voter on envelope and did not get it signed before canvass, and one (1) was turned in as the voter rejected their ballot.

Tron closed the election canvass.
