

**HUGOTON AIRPORT BOARD**  
**June 17, 2025**

Present: Robert Davis, Josh Jorde, Erick Nordling, Dax Gaskill, and Manager Scott Spikes  
Absent: Matt Rome

The meeting was called to order at 6:12 p.m., by President Robert Davis.

Reading of the Minutes. After reading the minutes of the April 15, 2025 regular meeting, **Josh moved seconded by Erick to approve the minutes of the April 15, 2025 regular meeting, as presented. Motion carried.**

Financial Report. There were no other bills for approval other than routine payments which Scott had already presented to the County for payment.

Manager's Report. Scott also noted that the AWOS equipment had failed due to a lightning strike, and that he has been working with the service provider to schedule repairs. He anticipates that they will be able to make the repairs within the next few days. Scott reported the A/C condensation leak in the hallway has been fixed. Also, he passed on suggestions for using trailer style LED lights for the tetrahedron rather than LED rope lighting, which tends to deteriorate with weather. He also reported that the City crew delivered gravel to fill the low spots by the fuel farm, which was greatly appreciated. The Board approved the bid from Alex Kinser to spray weeds for \$3,158.21 should begin this week. Scott noted the mower needs repairs for the drive train U-joints.

Scott reported that the new security camera system has been installed and is working well although there is still a blind spot which needs to be addressed. Arick Miller, the service tech, bid \$400 for another camera, for mounting a monitor, and related wiring. **Josh moved, seconded by Dax, to approve the additional camera, with installation and to mount the monitor for a total cost not to exceed \$400.00. The motion carried.**

Updates on Projects. Scott noted that the airport consultant reported two companies are now looking at the crack seal project. Scott will follow up with the airport consultant. He also reported that the FAA conducted its annual ground inspection of the airport AWOS (Automated Weather Observation System) on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. All equipment parameters and key inspection elements were within tolerance, except for damage caused by a lightning strike the day before the visit. Once the system is repaired, sensors must be tested with findings reported to the FAA point of contact.

New/Old Business. Robert mentioned that he met recently with the County Commissioners to keep them posted on the Airport activities and projects.

The business portion of the meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:30 p.m. The next meeting was tentatively scheduled for July 15, 2025.


