

Resolution No. 25-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF STEVENS, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the County of Stevens was calculated as 62.495 mills by the Stevens County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the County of Stevens will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 15, 2025, allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County of Stevens, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF STEVENS:


The County of Stevens shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 62.495 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.





Roll Call Vote


